- 2. To act in accordance with the Council Members' role and responsibilities.
- 3. To collaborate with the Chair to build and maintain trust to work productively with Council members.
- 4. To provide an alternative route for Members of Council and CSP Members to raise issues or concerns if they are unable to do so with the Chair.
- 5. To provide support and assistance to the Chair in carrying out his/her responsibilities and to act as a 'sounding board' and 'critical friend' to the Chair.
- 6. To support if required the annual process to review the performance of the Chair and of Council members, and their contribution to the work of Council and its Committees.
- 7. To act as an ambassador for the Society, engaging with members and members' networks and with external bodies.
- 8. To be a member of the ARC Agenda Committee.
- 9. To undertake assignments at the request of the Chair.
