Scientific Panel – Statistician

The Chartered Society of Physiotherapy Charitable Trust (CSPCT) is looking for a statistician to join its Scientific Panel.

This Scientific Panel administers CSPCT funds on a biannual basis through its research awards, following submission of proposals from Chartered Society of Physiotherapy (CSP) members.

Applications are invited from those with experience in healthcare statistics, preferably with an interest in physiotherapy research.

Individuals must be able to make a valuable contribution to the work of the Panel and have experience in/knowledge of the following areas:

- Medical statistics/ biostatistics
- A range of research methodologies (e.g. trials, epidemiological studies)
- Reviewing grant applications
- Research carried out by allied health professionals (desirable)

An interest in areas such as physical activity, musculoskeletal, injury, chronic pain, cardiometabolic disease and neurodegenerative diseases is preferable.

Details of your commitment:

- The term of office is four years
- Meetings are normally held virtually. However, travel and subsistence expenses are paid, should an in-person meeting be required
- Two 2-day meetings are held each year, usually in May and November
- Preparation for meetings is expected i.e. reading and assessing research proposals and progress reports, and collating brief feedback on each application.
- The statistician will review all applications, unless they have a conflict of interest
